2. Remember that I have come to learn, as I share the gospel of Jesus Christ. I may run across procedures that I feel are inefficient, or come across attitudes that I find close-minded, yet I will refrain from informing our hosts on "how to do things." I will be open to learning how other people do things, and their ideas.
3. Respect the host's view of Christianity. I recognize that Christianity has many faces throughout the world, and that the purpose of this trip is to share the gospel of Jesus Christ through my words and my actions.
4. Develop and maintain a servant's attitude toward all nationals and to my teammates.
5. Respect my team leaders and their decisions.
6. Refrain from gossip.
7. Refrain from complaining. I know that travel will present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering these circumstances are innumerable. With God's help, I will be creative and supportive.
8. Respect the work that is going on in the country.
